AFP Arizona Quick Guide to the Nov. 2, 2010 Ballot Propositions

Title	Subject	Short summary	Who's in favor?
<u>Prop 106</u>	<u>Health care</u>	Prohibits mandated participation in health care plans (this is the anti- ObamaCare proposition)	Most Arizona conservatives & libertarians
<u>Prop 107</u>	<u>Affirmative action</u>	Bans preferential treatment and hiring preferences in government employment	Most Arizona conservatives & libertarians
<u>Prop 109</u>	<u>Hunting</u>	Gives constitutional protection to the right to hunt in AZ	Most Arizona conservatives & libertarians
<u>Prop 110</u>	<u>Natural resources</u>	Authorizes exchange of state trust lands in order to protect military installations	Most Arizona conservatives & libertarians
<u>Prop 111</u>	<u>Govt admin</u>	Re-names the position of AZ Secretary of State to Lieutenant Governor	Mixed
<u>Prop 112</u>	<u>Initiative rights</u>	Changes citizen initiative petition drive deadline to two months earlier than current deadline	Mixed
<u>Prop 113</u>	<u>Labor</u>	Preserves the right of workers to have a secret ballot in union elections (anti Card-Check)	Most Arizona conservatives & libertarians
<u>Prop 203</u>	<u>Marijuana</u>	Legalizes and regulates the use of medical marijuana	Most Arizona libertarians
<u>Prop 301</u>	<u>State budgets</u>	Transfers money from the state's land-conservation fund to the state general fund	Most of AZ's conservative legislators
<u>Prop 302</u>	<u>State budgets</u>	Repeals the First Things First program and transfers its money to the state's general fund	Most of AZ's conservative legislators
