IMPORTANT:

1) You will need to register for the Defending the Dream Summit in order to ride the Americans for Prosperity bus to Washington DC for the weekend event. 2) The bus will be leaving from ONE location near Atlanta, GA which you will receive by this Friday after you have registered. You may pay online or by check for the fare. The round trip bus fare is a \$75 contribution online to Americans for Prosperity Foundation. You must email a copy of your receipt to joel.foster@afphq.org.
